I didn't have this completed for the newsletter, but on Thursday I delivered to LSSM, the quilts that our quilting ministry members have completed. (7 twin bed quilts, lap quilts, and a dozen receiving blankets)

LSSM was so delighted to receive them, I must tell the quilters thank you thank you thank you. You are so appreciated. The quilts will go to foster children. Seniors will receive the lap quilts, and of course new mothers will receive those soft baby blankets.

In the past we have sewn a tubular sack with a strap for foster children. I asked if this is the best way to provide for those children. LSSM tells me a back pack would actually be better.

As we did at the start of the school year, if you would consider, for Christmas, or by the first weekend in Advent, purchase a back pack and fill it with any and all types of items.

Helpful items include Hygiene items, of toothpaste and toothbrush, shampoo, bar soap, deodorant (depending on age of child you wish to assist), combs and brushes, washcloths, face tissue, socks, underwear, sweats, t shirts, barrettes and hair bands, stuffed animals, school supplies, reading books for different ages.

Label the bag for a boy or girl and bring them to church. I will make that delivery the week of December 7. Any foster children will benefit. These children often are only taking this bag provided for them, when they leave home. Thank you for taking LSSM into your home for the Christmas season.
